

Expectations whilst on Coach Journeys.

For the enjoyment of all members Escape endeavours to adhere to any requests made to ensure coach journeys are as relaxed and enjoyable as possible for all who attend, but cannot always accommodate every request.

The expectations are as follows;

- No member should board the coach until they have identified themselves to the coach leader to be checked off the list. Seats may be reserved for those with requests, or allocated if the coach is full.
- All family members must sit together at all times throughout the journey and remain seated at all times.
 The same seats must be used for the duration of the trip. Changing seats is not permitted without prior discussion with the coach leader, and in agreement with other members.
- Seatbelts MUST be worn at all times Escape's hire agreement with Berry's
 Coaches states; "All passengers 2 years and over must wear a seatbelt whilst
 travelling on board the coach as part of our terms and conditions."
 If a child/adult refuses to stay in their seat the coach driver has the authority
 to stop the coach at the nearest opportunity and refuse to continue until the
 child/adult sits down or gets off the coach as per Berry's Terms and Conditions
 below.
- Unders 2's must sit on laps at all times.
- When using mobile devices (tablets, ipads, phones etc) headphones must be
 worn at all times for the comfort of other coach users.
- For everyone's safety and enjoyment unruly behaviour/disrespectful language
 will not be accepted. The coach driver and coach leader have the authority to
 stop the coach and refuse to continue until the behaviour stops or the person
 exits the coach as per Berry's Terms and Conditions.

Coach Leader Role & Responsibilities

- All rubbish to be disposed of in bags supplied, or taken off the coach. The coach should be left as found.
- All children (or any adults who require additional support) must be accompanied to the toilet.
- For everyone's benefit, any issues with the toilet should be reported to the Coach Leader.
- No alcohol to be consumed on the journey See Berry's Terms and Conditions.
- Members must return to the coach at the stated time when at the services/venue to ensure a prompt arrival at the next destination.

BERRYS COACHES

RULES FOR THE COMFORT OF ALL PASSENGERS

Passengers are required to behave in a reasonable, sensible and lawful manner on a coach and are not permitted to:

- * Play music/games on the coach other than through headphones.
- * Bring onto the Company's vehicles or have in their possession, when on them, intoxicating liquor with the purpose of consuming it.
- * Take drinks or hot food onto the Company's vehicles.
- * Consume intoxicating liquor on the Company's vehicles.
- * Enter or remain upon the Company's vehicles having consumed intoxicating liquor or when drunk or under the influence of drugs.
- * Bring onto the Company's vehicles or have in their possession when on them, any drugs or medicinal products other than for medicinal purposes within the meaning of the Medicines Act, 1968.
- * Remain on the vehicle when directed to leave by the driver or other Company official on the grounds that he or she is causing a nuisance or being abusive or threatening to any other Passengers or staff.
- * Smoke in any section of any coach operated by the Company.
- * Use mobile phones except for emergencies or essential calls, keeping conversations to a minimum.
- * Behave in a manner which adversely affects the comfort and safety of other Passengers
